Dear International Friend,

Greetings from **CAMP-of-the-WOODS!** I hope that your studies are going well. I want to thank you for your interest in the summer ministry at **CAMP-of-the-WOODS.**

CAMP-of-the-WOODS is a large, non-denominational Christian family resort located in the Adirondack Mountains of upstate New York (about 4 hours northwest of New York City). We hire 250 students for the summer to help serve our guests. There are around 750 guests each week who come to **CAMP-of-the-WOODS** to hear great Bible teaching and to have a family vacation.

Of our 280 staff last summer, about 38 of them were international students. We hope to increase this number for this coming summer and hire as many as 50 international staff members. **CAMP-of-the-WOODS** is a great place to serve the Lord meaningfully while growing in your relationship with God. If you are on our staff, you will be challenged and will have many wonderful experiences. For more information about **CAMP-of-the-WOODS**, please check out all the links on our website.

Application Instructions for International Applicants

If you would like to apply to work at CAMP-of-the-WOODS, then you must meet the following conditions:

1. You must be a Christian who is in agreement with our Doctrinal Statement (See last page of application).
2. You must have a desire to serve God and to grow in your relationship with Him.
3. You must be a student and at least age 19 by June 1, 2008.
4. You must be able to speak conversational English fairly well.
5. **You must be able to come to the United States by June 10th and to stay until September 1st 2008.**
6. You must complete the **CAMP-of-the-WOODS** application and mail it to us by **January 15th, 2008** (or sooner)! Please note that you do **not** need to pay the \$5 USD application fee.

Two references are required for all first-time applicants. If you have been on our Summer Staff before, you do not need to complete them. **Here is how to complete the references:**

1. Put your name, address, and position(s) you are applying for on the top of each Reference Form.
2. Give the appropriate form to the appropriate person. Please note in the upper right hand corner the person to whom the reference form should be given.
3. Provide a stamped envelope with each form, addressed to yourself. **The evaluators will mail in the reference form directly to you, and you should include the unopened envelope in your application when you give it to us.**

If accepted for staff, you will get \$2,400.00 USD to cover your airfare, agency fees, insurance, and salary. Out of this, approximately \$450-\$550 will cover the fees for InterExchange, ICCP or CC USA, as well as the required health insurance. **You will be responsible to arrange and pay for your plane ticket to New York City (or Albany), as well as your travel from New York City to Albany or Amsterdam, New York (if needed).**

You should apply directly to CAMP-of-the-WOODS, not another agency first. **If you are accepted for our Summer Staff, then we will mail you an application for the agency that will help you to obtain the proper visa so you can work in the USA.** “InterExchange,” “ICCP” and “Camp Counselors USA” are the only agencies we are using at the present time, and **you should not complete their application until you have been accepted by CAMP-of-the-WOODS.**

Helpful Information for Our International Staff

The following paragraphs contain some helpful information to help make it a great summer for you at **CAMP-of-the-WOODS**. Because different cultures have different customs, we want to make sure you understand what to expect at **CAMP-of-the-WOODS**.

ENGLISH: Make sure to work on improving your English. One helpful way to do this is to speak in English all summer long, even when you are talking with someone who is from your own country. Also, carry a small pad of paper with you so that when you hear new words or new slang you can write it down. You will be amazed at how well your English speaking ability will improve.

CHAPEL: **CAMP-of-the-WOODS** is a non-denominational ministry, and our chapel services are probably much different than what you are used to. We are not a Catholic camp, and thus we do not offer mass on the grounds. Our worship services may seem informal and contemporary to you.

INTERNATIONAL NIGHT: We will have a special “International Night” that will be hosted by all of our international students. We want you to share with the American staff about your unique culture. I tell you this in advance in case there are certain items (clothes, props, recipes, books, etc.) that you want to bring with you from home. It will be a lot of fun!

HYGEINE: Different cultures have different expectations when it comes to the area of bathing and hygiene. **CAMP-of-the-WOODS** asks all staff to bathe regularly – at least 5 times a week. Also, please wear deodorant and/or perfume.

DRESS/CLOTHING: We ask all of our staff to dress **modestly and conservatively**. Again, every culture has different standards of what is considered appropriate. Shorts should be longer than your fingertips when your arms are resting at your sides. Skirts and dresses should not be short (they should end close to the knee). Also, please do not wear tight clothing or revealing clothing. **Staff are expected to wear appropriate undergarments**. Two-piece bathing suits are **NOT** allowed, but modest one-piece bathing suits are fine. Shorts-style swimming trunks for men are fine. Thank you for your cooperation.

ALCOHOL/SMOKING: American culture views alcohol/smoking differently than most other cultures. Because of this, we ask our staff not to drink alcoholic beverages or smoke while they are on staff.

PUNCTUALITY: We expect all staff to be on time to work and to meetings. Make sure you wear a watch and always be punctual. **We take this very seriously.**

E-MAIL: We have a computer center where you are able to use the internet. We provide you with a total of 6 hours free for the entire summer (you can purchase more time if you desire). This is a privilege only for International students.

LOCATION: **CAMP-of-the-WOODS** is located in a very beautiful and remote section of upstate New York. **There is no public transportation that comes near CAMP-of-the-WOODS**. The closest bus station is a one-hour drive from Camp. Therefore, it is not easy to leave the grounds. Many American staff will have vehicles, and you will become friends with them and they will take you places on your time off. Also, we plan official trips for our staff on occasion and Camp provides transportation for those trips. We will *try* to arrange for you to visit New York City (5 hours away) during the summer.

PASSPORTS: You can give your passport and other important documents (plane tickets, etc.) to the Personnel Office and we will hold on to them for you.
